Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to you with the final details of next week's adventure to Yenworthy.

- The coach will leave at 7.30am, please do not arrive before 7.15am.
- We will ring school when we arrive to let Mrs Durham know who will put a post outside school and on the school website.
- Any medicine or souvenir money should be clearly labelled and given to Miss Collinge.
- Please remember to take travel sickness tablets for the morning journey and to supply Miss Collinge with a labelled tablet for the return journey.
- All the children's luggage should be in one bag that they can carry. They can also have 'hand luggage' for the journey with a snack and drink for when we stop. They might also want a book or colouringbook, pack of cards or travel game. They do not need to be wearing outdoor activity clothes for the journey – jeans are fine.
- The children WILL need a packed lunch on Monday to eat at Yenworthy when they arrive. Please no glass or fizzy drinks. The lunchbox and drinks bottle can then be used during the week.
- Don't forget the cuddly toy and stamped addressed envelope and paper to write home.
- The packing list is on the Yenworthy website, <http://yenworthylodge.co.uk> **PLEASE** label everything. Remember warm layers are best and jeans are not suitable for outside activities.
- The children will know exactly which rooms they are in when we get there, but they will be with at least one person they have requested as a room mate.
- We are scheduled to arrive back in school around 8.00pm on Friday evening. If we are delayed we will ring school, if we know early enough and school will contact parents directly. If we are delayed later in the evening Miss Collinge and I will call parents directly on the contact number provided to let you know when we are due.
- There will be updated postings on the school website throughout the week, ICT permitting.
