### Lower School visit to the National Space Centre

Dear Lower School Parents,

On **Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> February**, as part of our new '*Reach for the Stars*' topic, we plan to take the children to the National Space Centre in Leicester. The trip is designed to excite their imaginations and extended their understanding, giving the children a hands-on experience and the opportunity to explore Space for themselves. The National Space Centre is the UK's largest planetarium, and is home to an iconic 42m high Rocket Tower. It is set to provide a truly out of this world experience! As part of the trip, the children will have the chance to explore all areas of the centre, as well as watch a show in the planetarium.



We will be leaving school at 9am and, depending on traffic, we will return between 3:30 - 4pm. The children should wear their school uniform, as well as a coat appropriate for the weather on the day. Comfortable school shoes or trainers suitable for walking should also be worn.

Children will require a packed lunch and a drink (no fizzy drinks). Please send lunches in a named plastic bag and ensure all contents are disposable. In addition, children should bring their usual water bottle, in a small backpack if possible, so that they can access it throughout the day.

The School Association have kindly helped towards the trip, lowering the cost to £15.50 per child. Please give consent and make payment online in the usual way, by Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> January. You do not need to return the slip below if you have given consent online.

Whilst the cost of this trip is perhaps a little higher than usual, we believe that the day will provide a fantastic learning experience and be a hugely valuable for the children. Costs will be recovered by the school for those in receipt of Pupil Premium funding. If you think that your child is eligible, please check with the school office. Should insufficient voluntary contributions be made, the trip will have to be cancelled.
