Upper School Topic Visit to the Black Country Living Museum, Dudley

An exciting Upper School visit has been planned to the Black Country Living Museum in Dudley as part of our Victorian topic. The visit has been scheduled for Tuesday 16th October 2018.

At the museum, the children will take part in activities such as a mining experience and tour; a Victorian school lesson; an accident investigator's workshop and a walk around a Victorian town. All of these experiences will enhance the work that the children have been doing so far on our topic.



The coach will leave school at 8:45 am prompt. The children will therefore need to arrive at school by 8:30 am to ensure that we can arrive by 10:30am. We aim to return to school between 5.30 and 6.00pm to ensure that we maximise our time at the museum. Pupils should bring a packed lunch, drink, snack and waterproof coat. To fully immerse ourselves in the experience, we would love it if the children could come dressed as a Victorian. They could be a maid, chimney sweep or even a member of the royal family. Please don't feel the need to buy expensive costumes, there are plenty of options using items that

you will have at home.

The cost is £10.00 per child, which we hope is great value for such an exciting visit. We would like to thank the School Association for subsidising this visit, in order to keep costs down for parents.

If payment and consent for this trip are given online, the slip below does not need to be returned to school. This payment is a voluntary contribution and no child or family will be discriminated against for not contributing.
