Year 3/4 (Current Year 2/3) - Residential Visit to Condover Hall (Shropshire) Activity Centre (March 2020)

In March 2020, Year 3 & 4 (currently Year 2 & 3) children have the opportunity to experience a residential visit to Condover Hall Activity Centre in Shropshire.

Considered as one of the most outstanding Elizabethan manor houses in England, the Grade I listed Condover Hall intertwines the charm of rural Britain with the latest technology to provide groups of all ages with an adventure to remember.

On Monday 30th March 2020, the children will leave Chesterton at approximately 10.30 am and arrive at Condover Hall at approximately 2.00pm. Packed lunch will be eaten on the journey. Once settled in there will be activities over the next two days, which could include: Archery, Zip Wire, Fencing and Climbing. All meals will be provided. The children will leave the centre at approximately 12.00 pm on

Wednesday 1st April to return to Chesterton by approximately 3.00 pm.

We believe that overnight residential opportunities offer our children a chance to use and develop their independence, and to experience outdoor learning activities that we cannot offer at school. In the past, these short residential trips were very successful, and everyone thoroughly enjoyed the experience.

The subsidised cost of this trip will be £122.00 per child. We appreciate that this is a significant cost, but feel that Condover Hall does offer really valuable experiences for the children that aren't available at school.

We will hold an information evening for parents and pupils on Wednesday 15th May after school. We are keen to take as many of the pupils as possible and if we are made aware of any potential issues, we hope that we can find a way of overcoming them. In 2018, we managed to take our entire Year 3/4 cohort and it would be fantastic if we didn't leave anyone behind again this time.
