Chestnut – Suggested by **Charlotte Lancaster** and **Ivo Szkonter**, **Caden Hawes** and **James Hales**, because "It has conkers that you can open," and "They can be very strong, tall and beautiful."

Hawthorn – Suggested by **Aidan Hanna**, **Luca Steptoe** and **Sebastian Dibsall**, because "Hawthorn is also known as the May Tree and May Day is celebrated at Chesterton School," "I like the berries," and "The white blossom looks like snow."

Rowan – Suggested by **Cariad Evans** because, "...in the Autumn it has red berries which are good for nature. The old Celtic name for the rowan tree means 'wizard'."

Tree Name	Year Group	Location	Do we already have any on the school site?	Did you know?
Chestnut	Year 2 from Sept 2021	Current Ash Class	Yes, at the bottom of the school field.	Chestnut belongs to the same family of trees as Oak and Beech.
Hawthorn	Eventually Year 4	Old Apple Class	Yes, one, at the front of the school by old Apple Class.	Our Hawthorn tree appears on the school logo! When Hawthorn begins to bloom, it is a sign that spring is turning into summer.
Rowan	4/5 (eventually Year 5 only)	New block	No, we will arrange to plant one in view of the classroom soon.	Miss Barrett personally chose this name from a shortlist given to her by the School Council. We have already started using this name.

Therefore, when our additional two classrooms open, the full list of class names will be as follows:

Reception – Maple, Year 1 – Beech, Year 2 – Chestnut, Year 3 – Ash, Year 4 – Hawthorn, Year 5 – Rowan and Year 6 – Oak. We decided that the name 'Apple Class' retired in December!
