Please send lunch, snack and their usual water bottle in a small backpack, so that they can access it throughout the day. In an effort to be more eco-friendly, and reduce the amount of plastic bags/food wrap that often come with school trip lunches, please send your child's lunch in a normal lunchbox/bag, that fits within their backpack. They will bring these boxes/bags back from the trip, for you to recycle or dispose of any waste at home.
