Year 2 and 3
Spring Term 2019**

Creative Curriculum: Art this term will be linked to our topic and we will be studying the work of Vincent Van Gogh and his artwork 'Starry Night'. The children will be using this as inspiration for their own pieces of Art.

We will also be developing our map skills in Geography through some field work exploration, looking at the school and the local area.

After half term, we will be learning about Neil Armstrong as a significant figure in the history of space exploration. In Design and Technology, we will be making our own moon buggies! We will be testing different materials and designs before creating our final product for our own moon exploration. In Science, we will be investigating forces and movement.

English: This term, we will be studying stories with recurring language, report writing and poems. The children will have the chance to write their own version of a story about a journey into space and create a report about one of the planets. We will also be looking at reciting poems. After half term, we will be looking at the author Roald Dahl and his famous book 'The Twits'. Finally, we will create reports about the planets and the space race.

Mathematics: In Maths, we will be exploring time, developing our knowledge and understanding of small and large units of time.

Alongside that we will also begin looking at fractions of a shape, groups of objects and numbers.

After half term we begin to look at how we measure an area of space and investigating angles.

French: This term, we begin our lessons learning French. We will be looking at France, learning about some of its key landmarks before moving onto some conversational skills based around a café and ordering food.

PSHCE: We will be revisiting what it means to have a Growth Mindset and how we apply that in the classroom.

We will then be thinking about 'getting on and falling out'; how to manage our friendships with others.

Physical Education: This term, the children in Year 3 will be going swimming.

In PE lessons with our sports coach, the pupils will be developing their skills in invasion games (such as netball and basketball).

Computing: Our work this term includes looking at developing our word processing skills to write an information page about space.

After half term, we will begin creating art work on the computers linked to our space topic.
