<u>Curriculum</u>

<u>Homework</u>

As in the spring term, for preparation for secondary school, the Year 6 children will be expected to complete **two** pieces of homework each week, one focusing on Reading, Writing or Maths and the other from the 'Enriching

Learning' homework sheet. Both are to be returned by the following **Wednesday**. Please also look out for weekly spelling lists, which will be provided by your child's spelling teacher. These will be handed out on Friday and the patterns tested the following Friday. Reading records will be checked every Monday. The children are expected to read at home for at least 20 minutes, three times a week and this should be recorded in their reading diary, by themselves or an adult.

<u>P.E.</u>

In term 5, the children will have P.E. on Wednesday and Thursdays. In Term 6, we will have P.E on Mondays (swimming) and Thursdays.





However, it is essential for the children have their kit and water bottle in school <u>every day</u>. All children

should have indoor and outdoor kit, such as shorts, t-shirt and trainers for indoor use, and tracksuit bottoms, a long-sleeved top and trainers for outdoor sessions. Please ensure that your child's PE kit is clearly named.

Health, Sex and Relationships Education:

Before the end of term, I will be leading Health, Sex and Relationships sessions. During these sessions we will be focusing on:

- Relationships
- How babies are made
- The birth of a baby

There will be opportunities for the children to ask questions and discuss the topics.
