Curriculum

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Homework

The 'Enriching Learning' homework sheet for our class will be posted on the school website and a copy can also be found in the children's homework books. The expectation is for one piece of homework to be returned to school,

completed, every **Wednesday**. Spelling homework will be handed out on a **Thursday**, by your child's spelling teacher, and will be tested on the following **Thursday**. Reading records will also be checked every **Friday**, but should be in school daily. The children are expected to read at home for at least 20 minutes, three times a week and this should be recorded in their reading record.

<u>P.E.</u>

For the first term, the children will have P.E. on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. However, it is essential for the children to have their kit in

school every day. All children should have indoor and outdoor kit, such as shorts, t-shirt and trainers for indoor use, and tracksuit bottoms, a long-sleeved top and trainers



for outdoor sessions. Please ensure that your child's PE kit is clearly named. During Tuesday's P.E. lesson, the children will be developing their problemsolving skills and, on a Wednesday, they will be furthering their

understanding of how to play Basketball.
