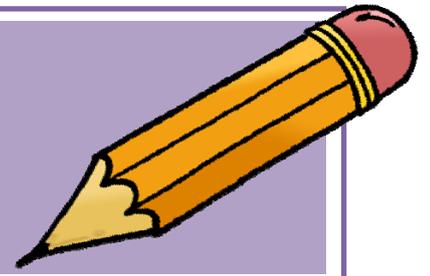


# Year 3

Each week, you need to choose one of these activities to complete and hand in on Wednesday in your homework book. Make sure that you choose a range of activities (some from each box) during the term.


### English Activities:

- Write a recount of one of your days from the Christmas holiday. Remember to write in chronological order.
- Imagine you are a girl or boy living in the Stone Age. Can you write a diary entry about a day in your life?
- Create a wordsearch for your weekly spellings. Can a friend or family member complete it?
- Research websites about the Stone Age, Bronze Age or Iron Age and find some interesting facts - you could use this information to write a report.



### Maths Activities:

- Draw different 2D shapes and see if you can split them into  $\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $\frac{1}{3}$ ,  $\frac{1}{4}$ , and  $\frac{1}{8}$ .
- Can you think of equivalent fractions to  $\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $\frac{1}{3}$ ,  $\frac{1}{4}$  and  $\frac{1}{8}$ ?
- Try subtracting three-digit numbers using either the expanded or compact column method. If you want to challenge yourself, choose numbers which involve exchanging.
- Create a poster on how you can learn and remember the nine times table. Is there a pattern in the answers?
- Don't forget to log onto Mathletics to try the Maths games!



### Topic Activities:

- Research a Stone Age recipe. If you choose to have a go at baking something, take some pictures to put in your homework book.
- Find out about some of the tools used in the Stone Age. Write a fact file.
- Compare the houses from the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age to modern day houses. What is the same and what is different?
- Research Stone Age clothes and design your own outfit. We would love to see your pictures!
- Take a trip to a local pre-historic site such as Rollright Stones.



**Personalised homework: Personalised homework:** Personalised homework is all about what you want to show us. Think about our topic (The Stone Age) and the events that are coming up. Then, create something to bring in and show, such as: a model or piece of creative art. Next term, we would like to show your creations in our museum.
