Pointillism



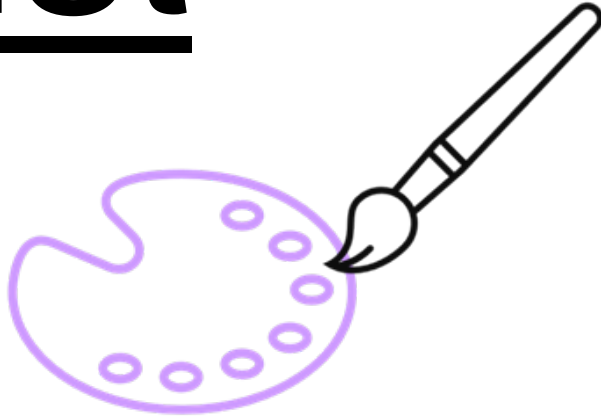
Pointillism reached its peak in the 1880s and 1890s after the impressionist movement.



Pointillism is an art where the picture is made out of tiny dots made one by one. It can take very long to make a good and detailed pointillism artwork.

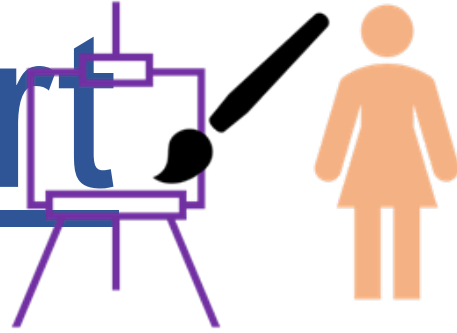
Cubist

Cubist art can be sometimes very dull or colourful. The artwork can also be interesting where one thing is mergeing into another.

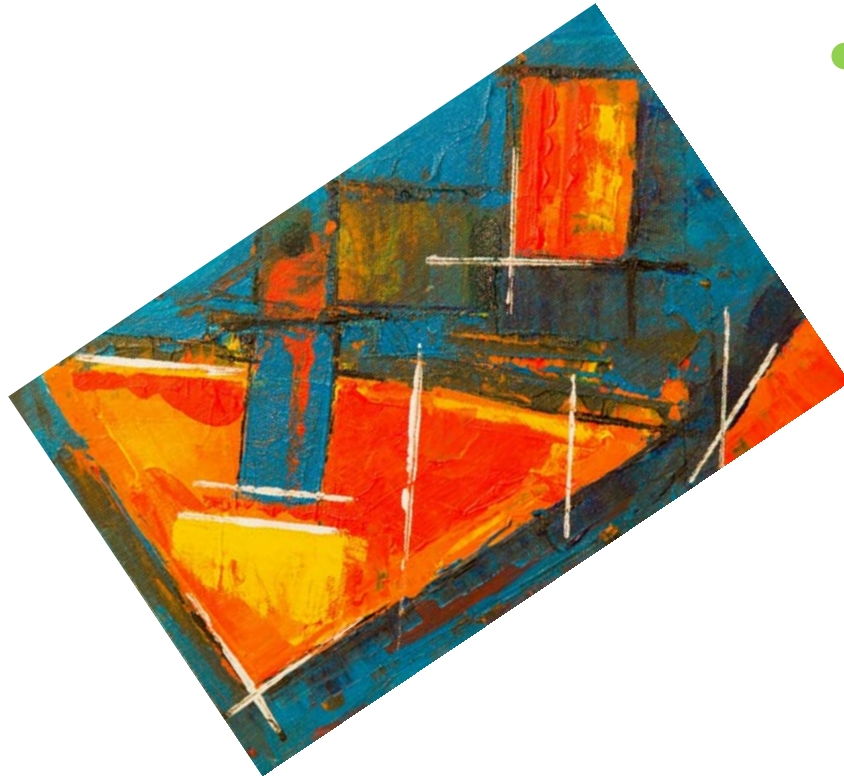


- Cubist is a type of art where the artist creates a simple artwork and then chops it up into small-ish pieces. Then, they would stick them around randomly, making an interesting image.
