Keep Dancing!


Watch out for Mr Horner's email about the dancing challenge. It would be great to see lots of Apple Class sharing their moves!

Getting colourful...



Joshua has been working hard all week on his Maths, English and Art.




Manasvi has created a map of North and South America.




Daisy has been very creative and has made a positive piece of art.
