Bethany R has been baking this week and she made an enormous cheese scone. It looks very impressive and I hear that it was also very tasty!




## Family Fondness!

Here are Max and Jess the cat sharing a book together. They appear to be reading 'Zog' by Julia Donaldson — what a great choice!







Meet Bethany R's new pet rabbit! His name is Rainbow Elsa, and I think you will agree, he is very fluffy and cute!
