## Community Spirit!


Benjamin and his brother created this excellent chalk drawing to show how grateful they are to the NHS. I am sure that this made many people smile, Benjamin!

Last week, I had a go at making my own pie after being inspired by Katie. I decided to use chicken, bacon and leek. I think it was the tastiest dinner I have ever made!








