Dear Parents and Carers,

Curriculum

Homework

The 'Enriching Learning' homework sheet will be posted on the school website with the expectation that one piece is to be returned to school, completed, every **Thursday**. Books will be returned to children on Friday. Alternatively, the children can complete the Mathletics task, which will be set and checked every **Thursday**, or challenge themselves on Times Tables Rock Stars.

Please look out for the weekly spelling/phonics pattern sheets, which will be provided by your child's spelling/phonics teacher every **Thursday**. Your child will be tested on words connected to this rule or pattern on the following **Thursday**.



Reading records will be checked every **Friday**. Please try to encourage your child to read regularly throughout the week. 5-10 minutes of extra reading daily, with an adult or independently, will really support the work that we do within school.

P.E.

In Term 5, the children will have their P.E. lesson on Monday. In Term 6, the children will have their P.E. lessons on Tuesday and Wednesday

P.E. kits should remain **in school at all times**, apart from when needing to be taken home to be washed. This is especially important for this term as our sessions may change to ensure that we have access to the May Pole! All children should have indoor and outdoor kit, including a house t-shirt, shorts, tracksuit bottoms, a warm long-sleeved top and trainers. **Please make sure that your child's P.E. kit and school uniform is clearly named.**

Reminders

- Water Bottles Please make sure children have a clear, named water bottle with them every day (separate from any drink in their lunchbox) as this allows access to water as and when they require it. Please note, there should only be water in these bottles (not squash, juice, flavoured or fizzy water).
- Summer Protection As we enter the summer months, all children should be prepared for outdoor play. Sun hats should be brought to school, and sun cream applied before the start of the school day. Children should also have coats on those rainier summer days!
